

### DID YOU KNOW?

To ensure your safety, we periodically test our lifeguard staff by using lifelike mannequins for simulated rescues. These simulated rescues are part of our Vigilance Awareness Training (VAT), and a requirement as a client of Jeff Ellis and Associates and the International Lifeguard Training Program. We conduct at least eight (8) of these simulated rescues per month at our Aquatic Center in order to maintain the highest level of lifeguard training in the industry.

## LEARN TO SWIM CLASSES

Swim Lessons are available for all ages and skill levels during the summer season. Classes are 35 minutes in length. **Dolphins:** Retrieve objects underwater with eyes open, beginning dives, treading water, changing direction, butterfly kick, and 15 yards of front crawl, back crawl, elementary back stroke. Ages 6 yrs & up

**Sharks:** Deep water bobbing, rotary breathing, diving from poolside, flip turns, butterfly, and refinement of front crawl, back stroke and breaststroke (25 yards). Ages 7 yrs & up
